## Acolyte

An acolyte is a man instituted by the Church to support the liturgical life of the parish at Mass. He distributes Holy Communion and sets up for Mass and cleans up after Mass. Commitment would be fortnightly. Training is provided before being instituted.

## Hospitality Group

This group supports one of the central messages of the Gospel: hospitality. This group organises the Sunday monthly morning tea, it also includes meeting with Fr Paul to coordinate other parish functions such as Parish Dinner, Parish Christmas BBQ.

## Altar Servers

Young people who have completed their First Holy Communion may be altar servers. Senior servers (high school) are also a valuable part of the team. Fr Peter and seminarian Gerard will provide training. Commitment is once a week or once a fortnight depending on numbers.

## Reader

Supports liturgical life of the parish through the ministry of reading at Mass. The commitment is once a month.

## Altar Society

A group that supports the liturgical life of the Parish by maintaining flowers, altar cloths, setting up for Weddings. Commitment is once a month.

## Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults

This group is for those who desire to join the Catholic Church. You may like to join the RCIA Team in supporting those who desire to join the Church.

## Catechist Primary

Volunteers receive formation from Archdiocese to teach religious education in public school. The commitment is weekly during school terms.

## Rosary Statue

This group gathers in peoples homes to pray The rosary each week. You are most welcome To join this group or volunteer to hold the Meeting in your home.

## Children's Liturgy

Supports the life of the liturgical life of the Parish. Children's liturgy operates at the 10.00am Mass each Sunday during school terms.

## St Vincent de Paul Men's Conference

This group operates in our parish in support of those in material need. The Men's Conference Meet each Wednesday night at the Parish Centre and discusses cases for the coming week. This group brings alive this vision of St Frederick Ozenam and works by the principles of social justice.

## Choir/ Organist/ Musician

A group that supports the liturgical life of the Parish by leading the music at Mass and other liturgical celebrations. Commitment is weekly with practices from time to time. You may also like to offer you talents as a Musician.

## St Vincent de Paul Women's Conference

The Women's Conference meet fortnightly on a Monday in the Parish Centre. The Conference support and coordinates initiatives such as Monthly Mass to Bupa Nursing Home Narwee, Christmas hampers, World Day of Prayer.

## Greeter

This person supports the notion of hospitality in the parish by welcoming people to Mass with a smile and joy. It is good to feel like you belong.

## Youth Group

The motto of the Youth Group is 'Fun, Food & faith'. This group is for young people in years 7-12. They meet fortnightly on Saturday night. The group is lead by a committee that plans each session and outings such as Laser tag.
